

NORT DAKOTA FFA ALUMNI ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I: OFFICIAL NAME OF THE ORGANIZATION

Section A: These By-Laws shall be considered a part of the Constitution of The North Dakota FFA Alumni Association.

ARTICLE II: LOCATION OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE

Section A: Shall be at the mailing address of the secretary/treasurer.

ARTICLE III: PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION OF THE FFA ALUMNI EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section A: The North Dakota FFA Alumni Executive Committee shall consist of:

1. The five (5) major officers: President, Past President, Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer and Reporter, shall be elected at large at the annual meeting of the association for a one (1) year term.
2. The President shall serve a maximum of two (2) consecutive terms.

Section B: Whenever a vacancy occurs on the North Dakota FFA Alumni Executive Committee, other than from expiration of their terms of office, the Executive Committee may appoint a person to fill the unexpired term of office.

ARTICLE IV: DUTIES OF THE ALUMNI EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section A: It shall be the duty of the Alumni Executive Committee to direct the operation of the Association in accordance with it's constitutional purposes.

ARTICLE V: TIME OF MEETINGS

Section A: Executive Committee and/or Membership will meet at least two (2) times per year.

1. The Annual meeting shall be held in January of each year.
2. A meeting shall also be held at the North Dakota State Fair.
3. Additional meetings of the North Dakota FFA Alumni Association shall be held at such place and time as may be prescribed by the North Dakota FFA Alumni Executive Committee.
4. Executive Committee meetings can be held at the call of The President.

ARTICLE VI: FISCAL YEAR

Section A: The fiscal year of the North Dakota FFA Alumni Association shall follow the National FFA fiscal year.

ARTICLE VII: REPORTS

Section A: The records of the North Dakota FFA Alumni Association shall be audited by an audit committee consisting of a minimum of three (3) of the following officers: President, Past President, Vice President or Reporter, and the findings will be reported at the Annual Meeting.

Section B: If a member requests an additional audit of the records of the North Dakota FFA Alumni Association by a certified CPA or attorney, it will be at the member's personal expense. Such member will inform the Executive Committee calling for an audit and shall be done within a reasonable time frame.

ARTICLE VIII: VOTING

Section A: Refer to Constitution Section A. Voting:

1. Each Chapter shall have up to three (3) voting delegates present at each meeting.
